The Summer Driver Education course being offered at Bishop Ludden consists of classroom instruction and in-car instruction. Students meet three times a week for in-car instruction **AND** three times a week for classroom instruction. The course is approved by the New York State Education Department. Successful completion will entitle the student to receive a MV 285 (formerly know as a “blue card”) and an insurance reduction certificate.
